Row 6: Cb (0), C# (2), Db (0), D# (2), Eb (0), Eb (1), Fb (2), F# (2), Gb (2).

Row 7: Gb (0), G# (23), Ab (12), Ab (1), A# (2), Bb (2), Bb (2), Cb (0).

*In some cases, 12 should be substituted with 3

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
